Who are the PTA?

The PTA Committee is currently formed by 3 parents and is supported by Mr Blackburn, school staff and other parents.

The function of the Committee is to organise and deliver fundraising activities and control how the funds raised are managed and invested.

At the end of each school year the Committee stands down to give the opportunity for other parents to join and form a new Committee, which will be voted in at the PTA's next Annual General Meeting (AGM) in September 2022.

PTA Fund Raising (Events)

The PTA organise and run events throughout the school year. Typically, these are:

- Halloween Disco
- Christmas Disco
- Quiz Night (Adults only)
- Family Bingo Night
- Summer Fair

PTA School Funding

In recent years, the PTA has made the following donations to the school:

- £ 10,000 for the purchase of new ipads (which has increased the ratio available to the children in their classrooms)
- Sponsored Book Week activities



PTA Meetings

PTA meetings are usually held during each half of the three school terms (every 5 to 6 weeks depending on event calendar), commencing at 7pm on a week-day evening, for about 1 hour. Specific dates will be communicated in the new school year. **All parents** and teachers are invited to attend these meetings where discussion covers the following:

- Organising events and activities
- Feedback
- School funding requests

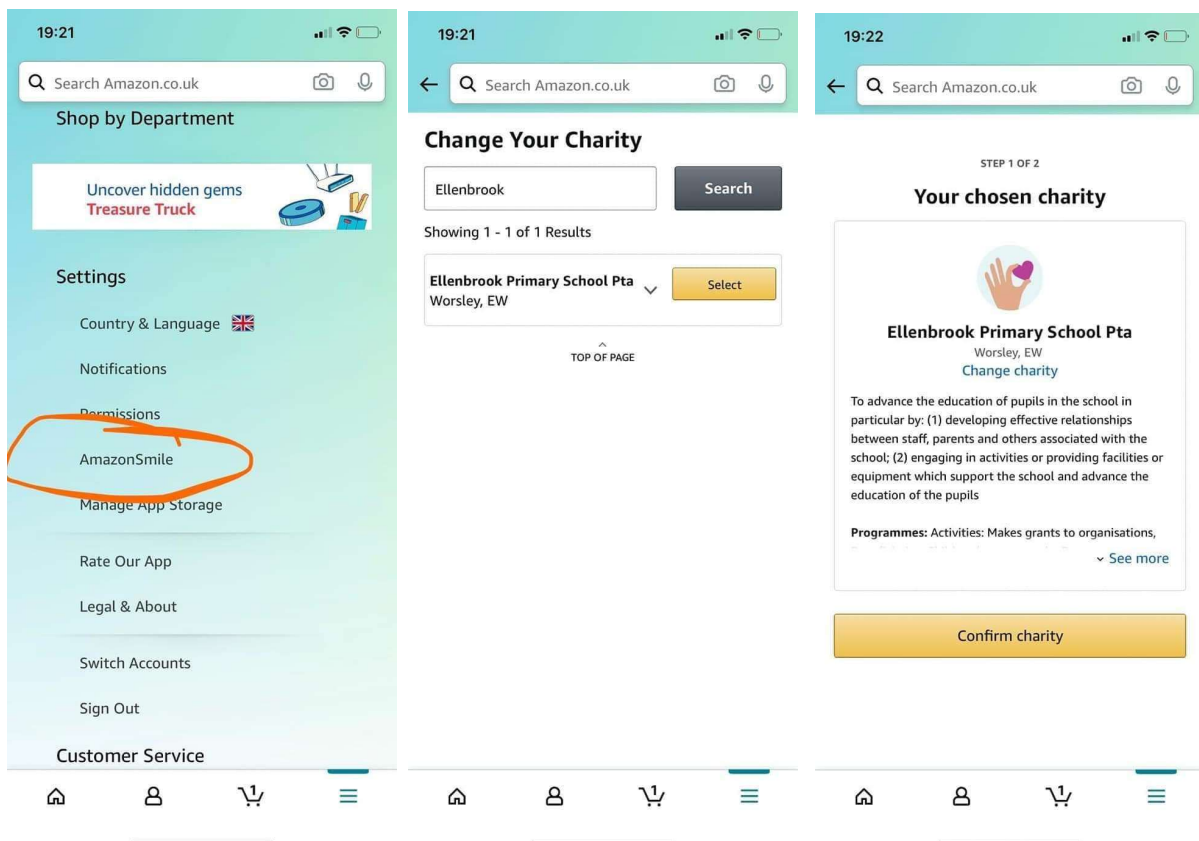

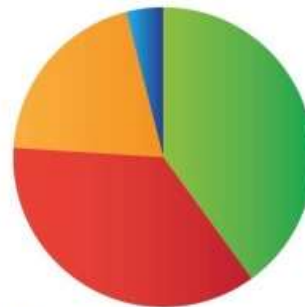
Draws are conducted every Saturday at 8pm and results are posted online. Winners will be notified via email and the winnings will be paid straight into an account of their choosing.
