School will close 31st March and open on **Tuesday 18th April**

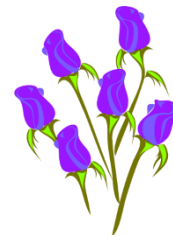
There are many other events and outings planned for the Spring term – remember to check your emails on a regular basis. All information will be sent by this system.
